"Feedback," in which he plays the electric guitar. The picture to the right is a cover of their latest album, "Rock My Soul." You can see him standing there left of center.






On the archabbey's web site, <u>you can</u> <u>purchase the CD</u>, and you will see quotes of the following media reviews of the "Rock My Soul" CD:

Here's another picture of the "cool" archabbot:




This picture unwittingly displays how it's either the guitar or the Cross: you cannot serve both the world and Christ!
