News Story Pervert priest not getting defrocked

Chihuahua, Chihuahua, 6th January 2003 (FIA).- The Bishop of Cuauhtémoc, Chihuahua, assured that he would not suspend the priest who appeared in a home-made video having sexual intercouse with his secretary.

Fragments of the video, which was recorded three years ago, were made public last week, by the newspaper "Diario de Chihuahua", causing indignation among Catholics in Mexico, who asked for the removal of the priest, Father Salomón Palma.

The Bishop of the Dioese of Cuauhtémoc, Juan Guillermo López, informed he would not punish Palma, because the actions registered in the video occured three years ago. Since that time, the woman is now living in the USA.

Palma regreted his actions and asked to be moved, published the diary this Monday, quoting that Bishop López had sent him to a spiritual retreat so that he would be rehabilitated and think about what he had done.

López asked the people to forgive the priest in his homilly this Sunday in Chihuahua, the capital of that state.
